












*Distibution of beneficiaries




Technology & Education

DOT Lebanon's EdTech Pillar exposes faculty and staff in education institutions to 21st century pedagogical methodologies. The program develops digital and blended modalities of the teachers, supporting students in enhancing their 21st century skills.

This program is based on the Teach-Up program offered by DOT Lebanon's professional trainers in education and technology who coach and train school teachers on new general and subject specific digital tools to transform classrooms and educational environments.

This program is also supported by DOT Lebanon's LMS DoTransform.





DOT Lebanon's Learning Management System (LMS) features our curricula in a digitized and gamified format, through a web interface or an online/offline mobile application.

The learning material is designed as a **self-paced model.** However, it caters for synchronous and asynchronous learning.



DOT Lebanon's Arabic and English Certified Training programs are accessible remotely through our DO Transform LMS synchronously and asynchronously; this will position us to be able to serve the youth in the MENA region through building local partnerships.

NEW CERTIFICATION

DOT Lebanon will launch a new partnership with Amazon Web Services (AWS) MENA Region. This promising partnership will open new doors for advanced certifications for our trainers/community leaders as well as our beneficiaries in the AWS training programs and allow them, at a later stage, to find income generation opportunities based on this certification.

This AWS re/start program is a full time skills development program aiming to prepare learners for careers in the cloud through real world scenario based learning and hands-on labs. Learners gain the technical skills they need for entry level cloud roles.

DOT CLIMATE CORPS

The climate program, which is a new product by DOT, will enable beneficiaries to lead a massive effort in climate awareness and resilience starting at the grassroot level.

At the end of their learning journey, the learners will develop:

- Awareness of local and gendered, individualized impacts of climate change in their communities.
- Competencies of champion community climate action included advocating for climate justice and intergenerational equity.
- Transferable digital, 21st century, gender equality, facilitation and mentorship skills to lead the green transition in their communities.
- Exposure and avenues of opportunity as ecopreneurs and in green-jobs in local green and blue economies.
